ACTIVITIES

The best known, and possibly the most authoritative Australian bird book, "What Bird Is That?" is being revised. One of the co-revisers is Arn McGill.

On the 14th November there will be a field trip to Blue Gum Creek - which Arn McGill will attend - the emphasis will be on birds, of course.

THE BOYD PLATEAU

The Boyd Plateau is a granite intrusion of some 35000 acres at an elevation of over 4000 feet. Because of its geology and location it is a superb and unique site for a National Park. The southern third, generally consisting of sandstone heath, has been included in Kanangra-Boyd National Park. The remainder is State Forest, which for the same reasons, and because it is cheap (Crown) land, is to be planted to pine to help support an integrated wood processing industry at Oberon.

The Government contends that the Plateau is essential to meet the goal of 100 000 acres of pines for Oberon. It says that other areas are "uneconomic", yet no analysis has compared the benefits from a plantation to the benefits from a National Park. There are other rationalisations but none are convincing.

The Colong Committee is organising the opposition to this rape as well as the opposition to the limestone mining of Colong Caves.
